What are Indexed Journals?

INDEXED JOURNALS are journals which get included in the catalogues of PRESTIGIOUS publishers after passing the evaluation of an independent CONTENT SELECTION COMMITTEE.

The journal, when indexed, appears in the Publishers' database.

What are Indexed Journals?

The journals continue to be in the Journal Masterlist when citations **remain strong**; otherwise, the Journal Title is **dropped** by the next year.

Publishers distribute the journals across the world.

What are thesis and dissertation repositories?

Repositories are digital online archives of thesis/dissertation maintained by University Libraries and other independent publishers.

Repositories of **independent publishers** are accessible for a **fee** while **repositories** of universities are **open-access**.

Repositories allow scholars to read the **FULL MANUSCRIPT** from cover-to-cover.

The **Philippine Electronic Journals** has now included a **thesis/dissertation repository** where deans and students can deposit their manuscript. The main advantage is the writers can be cited even of the thesis is not published in a journal.
